# Federal Capabilities Statement

VALOR Solutions Group is a Program & Project Management, Infrastructure & Facilities Planning, and Professional Consulting & Training firm. VALOR maintains a federal contracting presence by bidding, procuring, and performing federally funded projects from entities such as the Department of Defense, Veterans Administration, and United States Army Corps of Engineers. VALOR currently has 10 employees in the disciplines of architecture, engineering, environmental, urban and facilities planning, surveying, and information management. Project examples include: manpower planning initiatives, process improvement, technical directives upgrades & installations, consulting & leadership training, planning, environmental remediation, sustainable best practice advisement, and contract negotiation & administration.

**Program and Project Management** - VALOR utilizes the Project Management Institute's (PMI) principles in assisting with the initiating, data gathering, planning, executing, controlling, and closing all projects belonging to a portfolio or program, to include monitoring risks, costs, schedules and performance.

**Strategic Planning** - VALOR assists clients with defining strategies, or direction, and making decisions on allocating its resources to develop and execute these strategies.

**Performance Measurement** - VALOR uses a Program Management Information Systems' (PMIS) approach and utilizes "what-if" scenarios due to program forces affecting available funding, budgets and schedules to measure performance and program risks.

**Business Process Re-engineering** - Improvement and Management - VALOR utilizes several principles such as Lean Six Sigma (LSS) in evaluating, planning, executing and implementing system redesign and business process re-engineering, improvement and management. Our processes include the utilization of other tools and resources in measuring quality (Quality Measurement) such as those outlined in LSS, ISO 9000/9001, and the Malcolm Baldrige Quality Award criteria.

**Change Management and Transition** - VALOR utilizes methods to assist clients in their goals for effective and efficient organizational reshaping according to mission and goals.

**Data Governance** - VALOR utilizes its' PMIS approach in managing the availability, usability, integrity, and security of data affecting infrastructure and personnel.

## ***Training***

VALOR has DoD certified Master Training Specialists to provide personnel training via various mediums such as face to face, online or other hybrid format.

## ***Outreach***

Assists with clients' requirement in ensuring appropriate outreach is performed during key events such as organizational structure changes, facilities long-range planning changes, environmental assessments or other key event affecting employees and/or communities. Services include assistance with advertising services, media buying, public relations, and conference, events, and trade show planning.

## **Past Performance**

**Management and Improvement, Analysis, Outreach - Futenma Replacement (FRF) Program Management Office (PMO)** US Marine Corps, Okinawa, Japan. Services included facilities planning, project analysis, strategic planning, outreach and overall program and project controls. Program consists of relocation of a major Marine Corps Airfield to a new location. **VA Lexington Asbestos Abatement Project** - VALOR completed a multi-facility hospital room asbestos abatement project at the Veterans Administration facilities in Lexington Kentucky. The VALOR staff was able to complete the project and provide a rapid turnaround time of the cleared facilities for the hospital staff.

VALOR provided the oversight and management of the abatement phase of the project to remove the aged and sub-standard floor tile and mastic. VALOR then performed the tile replacement.
